

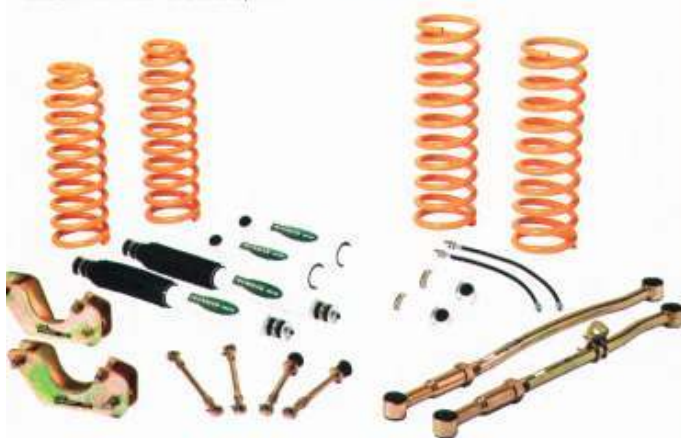
BUDGET BIG LIFT

Ironman 4X4 has just released complete 4in and 6in competition lift kits into the Aussie off-road scene. These packages suit the Toyota LandCruiser 80 and 105 Series live-axle models and GQ/GU Patrols.

Each kit comprises coil springs, foam cell shock absorbers, all the bracketry required to fit the kit including caster plates plus longer brake lines. All metal brackets, the

swaybar extensions and the Panhard rods are gold zinc plated for corrosion protection while the coils are powder-coated. Kits range from \$2014 up to \$2636 depending on the vehicle and lift height.

The third edition of HEMA maps has been completely revised and updated. At a scale of 1:250,000 the new version of Lakefield National Park now contains GPS surveyed roads and 4WD tracks. Coverage has been expanded to include Cape Melville National Park too. The map has great 4WD track detail and shows all of the park's bush camping sites.

DESKTOP MAPS

Geoscience Australia has released a new range of 1:250,000-scale 'geo-referenced' PDF topographic maps for all of Australia. The geo-referencing capability of geoMAP 250K gives co-ordinates, allows measurement of distance and area, the import of overlay data and importantly, GPS tracking.

With a set of 20,000 alphabetically arranged bookmarks, you can quickly navigate to locations across Australia. Alternatively, common pan and zoom tools allow navigation to the desired area. You can also select a map by simply clicking anywhere on the Australia index map.

To use the geo-reference capability of geoMAP 250K - needed for use with GPS or to find geographic co-ordinates -

additional software is required. Both types of software are available for download free of charge, with links to the software websites included with the product.
